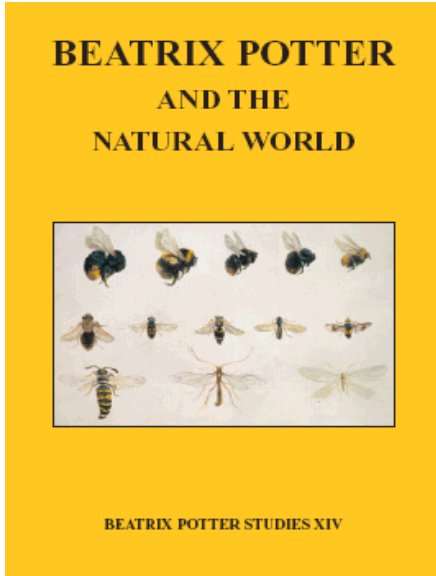

Beatrix Potter and the Natural World

Beatrix Potter Studies XIV

The theme of the Fourteenth Beatrix Potter Society International Conference in July 2010 was one close to Beatrix Potter's heart - the natural world. This new publication in the *Studies* series records the talks given at that Conference.

Katherine Chandler demonstrates how to be a naturalist, quoting from Beatrix's *Journal* and showing her natural history artwork; **Gary Primrose** looks at the flora on Beatrix's farms; **Peter Hollindale** discusses her knowledge of squirrels in relation to her little books; **Linda Lear** investigates Beatrix's scientific approach to the natural world; **Tom Attwood** notes the challenges of gardening in the Lake District; and **Susan Denyer** explores Beatrix's legacy in terms of landscape development and possible World Heritage status for the area. Also included here is **Liz Hunter MacFarlane's** survey of Beatrix's links with cookery and food.
